



## **East Diablo Youth Soccer League Players Bill of Rights**

1. The right to enjoyment both in practice and in competition, with a wide variety of activities that promote fun and easy learning
2. The right to participate at a level that is commensurate with each player's developmental level
3. The right to play as a child and not be treated like an adult, either on or off the playing field
4. The right to participate in competition with simplified rules, adapted to their level of ability and capacity in each stage of their evolution
5. The right to play in conditions of greatest possible safety
6. The right to participate in all aspects of the game
7. Right to have qualified coaches
8. The right to gain experience by resolving most of the problems that arise during the practice or competition
9. The right to be treated with dignity by the coach, their teammates, and by their opponents
10. The right not to become a champion
